FRAME Workshop

A new square for "Pratocentenario" neighborhood

FRAME is a proposal for a public space, a geometric design that regenerates a neighborhood and stimulates the collective imagination.

Frame is a workshop within Piazze Aperte, the tactical urbanism program promoted by the Municipality of Milan and developed by AMAT (...) in collaboration with Bloomberg (...) and co-financed by the European Union through EIT Urban Mobility (a body of EIT - European Institute of Innovation and Technology) within "CLEAR" project.

FRAME is in Pratocentenario (MI), an old district that has radically changed its appearance since the Second World War: few buildings from the early 1900s rise inbetween the ones generated by the economic boom that had erased the image of the small village. Today the district identifies as its center the crossroad named Largo San Dionigi. Pratocentenario is missing a square.

FRAME is a process of collective realization that engages all citizens, an inclusive and transversal workshop for all ages and backgrounds.

FRAME is activation, the transformation of the city and the creation of a public space usually pass through a phase of closure to public, the workshop aims at reducing the gap between citizens and the space in progress thanks to the practice of the open construction site. The process allows organizers and participants to constantly access the square, creating the opportunity for convivial moments, sharing and discussion.

FRAME is a practical workshop, where participants will be guided in the process of creating the square, thanks to the tutoring of experienced staff in the construction of large drawings on the ground.

INTRODUCTION

FRAME is a tactical urbanism workshop organised within the Milanese program “Piazze Aperte”. The project aims to enhance a portion of inert asphalt which will be subtracted from the driveway to become a place to meet and socialise: a new square for Pratocentenaro neighbourhood

Location: Milan, Pratocentenaro [Largo San Dionigi]

Duration: 8 days [from September 27th to October 4th 2022]

Number of participants: 12 [two groups of 6 people]

Timetable: Morning > 10:00 - 14:00 | Afternoon > 14:00 - 18:00 [half a day presence required per group]

Price: Free

PROGRAM

DAY 1: Workshop introduction and open lectures during the morning
Division of participants into 2 groups
Organisation of the tasks and first visit to the site during the afternoon

DAY 2 to 7: Realisation of the project [on-site work]

> *Meeting Point:* Largo San Dionigi

Participants will work in teams of 6 people, organised in half-day shifts in order to carry out the work either in the morning or in the afternoon. Both teams will be involved in the different phases of the project until its completion
